Re: Operator Workshop - SCADA Master Plan and AFNWA Update

As you are aware, the Atlantic First Nations Water Authority (AFNWA) is developing a SCADA Master Plan through its consultant, Eramosa Engineering. After documenting the current state of SCADA systems in participating communities, we are now moving to the next stage to develop a desired state solution. This will involve the production of three technical memos over the next month which we would like to share with you ahead of a planned workshop currently proposed for July 27, 2021. The Tech Memos cover topics including:

- Remote Terminal Unit [RTU] and Human Machine Interface [HMI] Recommendations
- Communications, SCADA Architecture, and Cybersecurity
- Data Management and Alarm Management

As part of the Desired State solution, we will be inviting feedback ahead of the workshop but request active participation in the workshop to ensure Operators voices are heard and the proposed solutions meet your collective needs. Itis our intention to leverage investments to date and over time move to the desired state to complement the utility's Hub and Spoke model. The following outlines the tentative agenda for the workshop:

- 4. Present Desired State Recommendations
- 5. SCADA Master Plan Next Steps
